swing traders primarily use technical analysis to look for trading opportunities these traders may utilize fundamental analysis in addition to analyzing price trends and patterns swing trading involves taking trades that last a couple of days up to several months in order to profit from an anticipated price move swing trading exposes a trader to overnight and weekend risk where the price could gap and open the following session at a substantially different price swing traders can take profits utilizing an established risk reward ratio based on a stop loss and profit target or they can take profits or losses based on a technical indicator or price action movements typically swing trading involves holding a position either long or short for more than one trading session but usually not longer than several weeks or a couple of months this is a general time frame as some trades may last longer than a couple of months yet the trader may still consider them swing trades swing trades can also occur during a trading session though this is a rare outcome that is brought about by extremely volatile conditions the goal of swing trading is to capture a chunk of a potential price move while some traders seek out volatile stocks with lots of movement others may prefer more sedate stocks in either case swing trading is the process of identifying where an asset's price is likely to move next entering a position and then capturing a chunk of the profit if that move materializes successful swing traders are only looking to capture a chunk of the expected price move and then move on to the next opportunity swing trading is one of the most popular forms of active trading where traders look for intermediate term opportunities using various forms of technical analysis if you're interested in swing trading you should be intimately familiar with technical analysis swing traders primarily use technical analysis due to the short term nature of the trades that said fundamental analysis can be used to enhance the analysis for example if a swing trader sees a bullish setup in a stock they may want to verify that the fundamentals of the asset look favorable or are improving also
